HUMAN RESOURCES

Supplemental Employee Retirement Plan (SERP)

On August 21, 2024, the District approved a Supplemental Employee Retirement Plan (SERP), providing participating employees with additional monthly income alongside their regular STRS or PERS benefits.

- Employee must be eligible to retire from CalSTRS or CalPERS by June 30, 2025.
- Keenan Financial Services representatives met with eligible employees to explain plan details and assist throughout the SERP process.
- The District's goal is to ensure that each eligible employee understands their retirement benefits, allowing for an informed decision.
- Participation is voluntary, and attending informational meetings is not a commitment to retire.

The deadline for eligible employees to submit the SERP package is October 8, 2024


