After extensive discussions over the last few semesters, it has been determined that an ASL Certificate is not a viable pathway to pursue. There is not enough direct vocational data to support an ASL only certificate. It is possible that an Interpreting Certificate could be a future pursuit. At the current time, the best program pathway to pursue seems to be establishing an A.A. in American Sign Language. This will be explored during the Spring 2018 semester.
