	The IVC apprenticeship program is solely funded by the IID and therefore funds courses with very low enrollment where IVC would not hold under normal circumstances. After the completion of the ELTT 101-104, only IID apprentices are allowed to continue in the 105-108 courses for the completion of the program. The IID provides financial incentives to these employees after reaching certain benchmarks.
	With financial and job security provided at the completion of the program, there is little incentives for these employees to solicit their certificates. It is even more difficult to get apprentices to complete the required general education courses for an associate degree.
