Gallery hours need to be expanded to make full use of the space for students, faculty, staff, administrators and the community.

- 861 Increase Programming at Art Gallery
Increased programming at the art gallery would bring greater enrichment to the IVC community. A budget for exhibits, lectures, film showings and other cultural events would enliven the educational opportunities for students.
UPDATE - 11/16/2017 - We have decided to work with other areas on campus for programming.
- 928 Misc. supplies needed to operate
The art gallery needs to be able to purchase paint for walls, packing materials to ship artwork back to artists or return to artists, and special cleaners to remove paint residue and clean plexiglass.
While these are truly instructional supplies because they are used by the gallery display (Art 262, 263 and 264) students to learn the function of a small art gallery, they are not traditionally considered to be so.
