I. Presentation

1. Canvas Limitations - Xochitl Tirado

Changes that are coming regarding Canvas courses - Winter 2023

- These changes are due to security issues.
- Ability to add people to your course will be removed, the reason is due to faculty adding students to Canvas but not adding them to their official roster which causes problems later. Now if faculty want to add someone, they will need to submit a ticket and the Ed Techs will all them. Tickets will need to be submitted to add embedded tutors and conversation partners.
- Create new course option will be turned off. Unauthorized courses have been created and there is limited space, this will alleviate those issues. Faculty will be able to keep sandbox courses as long as they include the word sandbox and the subject and course number. Moving forward if you need a sandbox course a ticket can be submitted and one will be created.
- All faculty and staff should be using their IVC email in Canvas.
- Ability of students to change their names will be removed. Students should use the appropriate form to change their name through A&R.
- An email will be sent to faculty with the changes.
