C. New Course - CHEM 230

Motion by Daniel Gilison, second by Kristen Gomez, to approve the addition of CHEM 230, as presented, effective 2022-2023, contingent upon articulation approvals for CSU GE-B and IGETC.

Final Resolution: Motion Carries

Daniel Gilison - Analytical Chemistry. The department would like to consider some additional degree and/or certificate options that this course will fit into. It can be used as GE and will be part of General Science and University Studies.

Kristen Gomez - This course is part of the lower division preparation for San Diego State; should hear back in May regarding CSU GE-B; July 2022 it will go forward for IGETC.

D. New Course - ESL 108

Motion by Andrew Robinson, second by Sydney Rice, to approve the addition of ESL 108, as presented, effective 2022-2023, contingent upon articulation approvals for CSU GE-B and IGETC.

Final Resolution: Motion Carries

Sydney Rice - this course was developed to provide ESL students an option to complete the transfer requirement; they can choose to go into ESL 005,

Kristen provided clarification for what GE patterns we are looking for inclusion CSU GE-B A2 and IVC GE area A2; and it would meet the reading and writing requirement.

Xochitl Tirado - the English department expressed concern that the instructor be qualified to teach ESL and English as the instruction will need to be equivalent to ENGL 110. The department is not opposed to this course.

Kristen Gomez - regarding GE requirements; criteria is followed in order to be submitted for those areas. The course was modeled after a course from another college that was approved for CSU GE-B and IGETC.

Members agreed that this was a need for our ESL students.

E. New Course - MUS 104

Motion by Carol Hegarty, second by Andrew Robinson, to approve the addition of MUS 104, as presented, effective 2022-2023, contingent upon articulation approvals for CSU GE-B and IGETC.

Final Resolution: Motion Carries

Carol Hegarty - this course will provide an option for students interested in world music.

Kristen Gomez - reminded that the earliest this may be offered would be Fall 2023 due to the need to get IGETC approval.

Discussion regarding 2-year pathway documents including adding an icon to programs that are offered fully online. Review of GE patterns and majors to help advertise those programs that are offered fully online. Consider OER icons for programs as well.

- Kristen noticed notations from other colleges that referred to programs that were offered fully online; we could look at our programs to determine if that idea would work for us. We could determine our icons and where/how to apply them.
- Steven noted that this type of identification may help with our enrollment outreach. For example, a course offered with the OER designation may fill faster since students are aware that they will not need to purchase an expensive text. Looking forward to next semester and reviewing our 2-year pathway document updates.
- Kristen - talk about where we can house this type of information, possibly use CurriQunet to provide pathways for departments to work on.
- Dixie will reach out to CurriQunet to find out what functionality the system currently has or what options are available.
