- **Flu Shots Available at Local Pharmacies:** It's that time of year again where the flu shows up for the holidays. Remember that your ICSVEBA Plan covers flu shots for you and your covered dependents if you visit a participating pharmacy. Just visit any one of the contracted Express Scripts retail pharmacies in your area to receive your flu shot for \$0 copay. To obtain a list of contracted pharmacies, please visit your Human Resources Department, or logon to ICSVEBA.org and click on 'Wellness'.
- **Dependent Social Security Request:** The Affordable Care Act, also known as health care reform, requires all districts within ICSVEBA to collect Social Security Numbers of each person enrolled in our medical plan – and that includes your covered dependents. We need to report this information to the Internal Revenue Service in order to comply with health care reform law. Please make sure you include the S.S.N. (as well as name and address) for all your covered dependents when completing your benefit elections this year.
